#### **STATEMENT OF OUR STEWARDSHIP**—YTD September 30, 2023

Statement of Our Stewardship for the nine months ended September 30, 2023, reflects a surplus of \$44,286 compared to Budget of \$9,270. Favorable to Budget of \$35,016 is primarily due to higher pledges received during the year. However, the surplus is expected to be reduced by much needed capital expenses such as a new smoke alarm that has fully addressable smoke and heat detectors for the entire building interfacing with Ready Set Grow's smoke alarm system. The expected cost is approximately \$38,000.

This year's Consecrating Stewardship theme "**Thanks for Giving**" is an opportunity to give to help others as an act of faith and an act of love. We give because God is the greatest giver. All that we have – indeed, all that we are – comes from God. God gives us his love every day. God promises us repayment for our generosity. Give and it shall be given back to you...
